Abstract

Domestic and wild pigs (*Sus scrofa*) are susceptible to a wide range of infectious and parasitic diseases. Some of these diseases are specifically limited to pigs while some of the other diseases are common to other species of wildlife and domestic livestock. As the numbers and geographic distribution of wild and domestic swine continue to increase, increased human activity and use of land for human habitation will increase the interface between human, wild animal and domestic livestock. Here, we report the disease(s) of wild boar in Malaysia which have the potential to infect humans and other livestock.
