Instructions for Abstract Submission and Presentation

Invited speakers for scientific sessions are required to submit an <u>extended abstract</u> of their presentation. The extended abstracts can be divided into several paragraphs and may include tables and figures. <u>The upper limit for the text of the extended abstract is 1000 words</u> (excluding title, author and co-author names, affiliate institutions and sub-headings). These abstracts must be submitted to the scientific committee at <u>gayavet@gmail.com</u> before **31**st **May 2013.**

Registration

All invited speakers will have their registration fee waived. However, registration for the conference is necessary.

Speaker Disclosure of Potential Conflicts of Interest

The ASVP Scientific Committee requires that all presentations be free of commercial or any related biasness as possible and that any information on commercial products or services be based on already generally accepted situation. It is also preferred that generic drug names be used wherever possible and that any presentation referring to unlabelled or research-associated commercial products should be disclosed to session participants. Speakers should also refrain from engaging in sensitive issues of any related countries, religion, races etc.

Presentation Format

Presentation shall be of highly professional and educational impacts. A presentation should be planned, coordinated, evaluated and delivered in terms of achieving these impacts.

Audio Visual Requirements

Venue for the conference will be prepared with audio visual requirements for PowerPoint presentations. Speakers should express any special needs in advance during registration at the registration table.
