BACKGROUND:

Following the successful conduct of the 15th FAVA Congress and FAVA-OIE Joint Symposium held in Bangkok, Thailand on 27-30, October 2008, the Philippine Veterinary Medical Association (PVMA) take pride in hosting the 16th FAVA Congress at the Queen City of Smiles Cebu City, Philippines.
