## BACKGROUND:

Following the successful conduct of the 15<sup>th</sup> FAVA Congress and FAVA-OIE Joint Symposium held in Bangkok, Thailand on 27-30, October 2008, the Philippine Veterinary Medical Association (PVMA) take pride in hosting the 16<sup>th</sup> FAVA Congress at the Queen City of Smiles Cebu City, Philippines. On its third time to host the FAVA congress (Manila, 1978 and 1992), the PVMA coincide conduct of the FAVA Congress with its 78<sup>th</sup> Scientific Conference and Annual Convention.
